It is a paved road all the way back into camp and is in good condition. There are 15 campsites nestled amongst big, beautiful oak trees with stalls at each site. They are all easy to get in and out of and if assistance is needed, Jerry and I will be there to help! There is a round pen, arena, wash rack, hitching posts, flushing toilets and water at each campsite. The campsite is located on 40 acres and has access to the California Riding and Hiking Trail and only a short distance to the PCT.

We will be hosting all meals starting with supper on Thursday night to breakfast Monday morning. Please let me know if you have any food allergies and I will do my best to make accommodation for you. We are black coffee drinkers, so if you like flavored cream in your coffee please provide your own, we will have milk and heavy cream available, but as Jerry would say "none of that foo foo stuff".

If you would like to join us, please contact me and reserve your spot today. We ask that you RSVP no later than March 10<sup>th</sup>. A 50% nonrefundable deposit is required to hold your spot.
